# **ACCOMMODATIONS AND TRAVEL**

### **Transportation**

The Organizing Committee recommends that teams fly into Boston, Massachusetts or Hartford, Connecticut. Harris Hill can arrange for pick up at these airports with advanced notice. (Deadline 2/1/22)

# Lodging

Harris Hill will provide lodging for Friday and Saturday nights. Multiple occupancy (athletes 3-4 to a room, coaches 2 to a room) will be necessary as rooms are limited. ### **COVID-19 Protocol**

The Harris Hill Ski Jump (HHSJ) is dedicated to protecting the health and safety of athletes, staff, and spectators, while promoting excellence and performance during these uncertain times. In response to the COVID pandemic, HHSJ will comply with local, state and US laws and regulations, and will continue to modify and adopt best practices to help ensure the safety of the athletes, staff and spectators for this year's event. The following recommendations represent current best practices, but as medical recommendations are ever changing and are based on the current state of the pandemic, these recommendations are subject to change.

# Competitors

Euro Athletes/Coaches will need to show proof of vaccination and a COVID-19 viral-antigen test (regardless of vaccination status or citizenship) no more than 1 day before travel by air into the United States. A negative test result must be shown to the airline before boarding.

*US Athletes/Coaches* will need to show proof of vaccination. If non-vaccinated they must remain masked at ALL times (gaiters and bandanas are not acceptable). All are required to have tested negative for Covid-19 prior to and upon arrival at this event.

We strongly advise coaches to bring a touchless thermometer and a supply of test kits to have on hand, since kits are in short supply in this area.

Along with hand washing and good sanitization practices, physical distancing and masking are the two most effective strategies for preventing the spread of Covid-19.

ALL athletes/coaches must bring and carry a well-fitting mask, of at least two layers (gaiters and bandanas are not acceptable) to wear in areas where social distancing is not possible (i.e. buses, tents, etc.) \*\*Brattleboro REQUIRES, per town ordinance, masking for everyone in indoor public areas.

#### For the duration of the event

Please monitor the athletes for fever and cold symptoms that could indicate COVID-19. If an individual has a positive test or experiences a fever of > 99.9F or 37.7 C, new cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, diarrhea or nausea, please inform coaches and Kate McGinn, the event coordinator, immediately. The individual may not attend the HHSJ event, or if at the event, must immediately return to the hotel and isolate in their room. If a daily test delivers an equivocal or indeterminate result, the participant must repeat the test and obtain a clear positive or negative test result to determine if they can participate in the HHSJ event that day.
