**Jumpapalooza: USA Nordic National Championships**  
**September 30-October 1, 2022**  
**Lake Placid, NY**

The Olympic Regional Development Authority cordially invites athletes to participate in the Jumpapalooza: USA Nordic National Championships on September 30<sup>th</sup> and October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, in Lake Placid, NY. The competitions will be held in compliance with FIS [International Ski Competition Rules \(ICR\)](#).

In collaboration with the Buck Island Ski Club, athletes, coaches, and spectators are invited to enjoy the Jumpapalooza festivities throughout the weekend's competitions. The Olympic Jumping Complex will feature games, inflatables, vendors, and food, as well as live music from [Annie in the Water](#) and [The Big Takeover](#). Jumpapalooza will conclude with a fireworks display on Saturday at 21:00.

The Buck Island Ski Club (BISC) is a 510(3)c non-profit corporation dedicated to promoting good boating etiquette, and lake stewardship on Lake Placid. They also promote the winter sport of Nordic ski jumping through organization and support of the Sorcerer of Fun Jumpapalooza festival and scholarship fund; and a vivacious embrace of life and all it embodies.

The inspiration for Jumpapalooza is Jeffrey "Huge" Volmrich aka The Sorcerer of Fun. Jeff was an athlete, husband, brother, son, father, mentor, and friend. Born in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania on January 22, 1964, Jeff spent his summers at his family's camp on Buck Island in Lake Placid which became a spiritual center for him. In 1974, Jeff's family relocated to Lake Placid full time, and he was introduced to the sport of Nordic ski jumping. Jeff graduated from Northwood School in Lake Placid and went on to attend St. Lawrence University where many of his lifelong friendships were born.

A gifted athlete from a young age, Jeff became the Junior National Ski Jumping Champion at age 14, and competed on the World Cup for the U.S. Ski Team where he was a member from 1981 until 1989. Jeff was also a nationally ranked water skier, an avid telemark skier, and a skilled fly fisherman. There were few sports that Jeff did not excel at once he put his mind to them. There will be a satellite race office in Wax Cabin 1 at Mt. Van Hoevenberg.
